Resilience - The Crux of Crisis

Jesse’s keynote sets out his universally applicable mental framework, honed through his climbing, as a tool to build and fortify resilience. He is an exemplar of the criticality of agency, illustrated by his choice to continue to lead in his climbing, a powerful subversion of typical disability narratives, he turns a story of reliance into one of purpose, leadership and self-determination. The keynote equips delegates with a set of practical tools and guides them along the path to foster and nourish their own and their organisation’s resilience by reclaiming agency.

Adversity - Facing down the Fade

Jesse’s keynote looks past the typical “inspiration” tropes to offer a tactical, high-performance framework for how to remain effective and thrive in the most challenging, high-stakes circumstances imaginable. He provides the audience actionable and widely applicable techniques that allow him to remain cool-headed and objective focused as well as how to accurately assess and effectively manage risk in some of the world’s most hostile environments and harrowing situations.

Adventure - The Unseen Horizon

Adventure is often defined by what we see – the vast landscapes, the towering peaks, the distant horizons. But clearly, there is so much more. In this keynote, Jesse eloquently expands on this limited view, from the importance of preparation and accurate risk assessment and mitigation to the chance to grow, build confidence and develop deep interpersonal relationships. The ability to learn from adventure recasts our approach in all contexts. Jesse relates synergies in the mindset required for success in remote and extreme situations to those attitudes that support achievement in any context.
